

# Stand Up Cat Craft

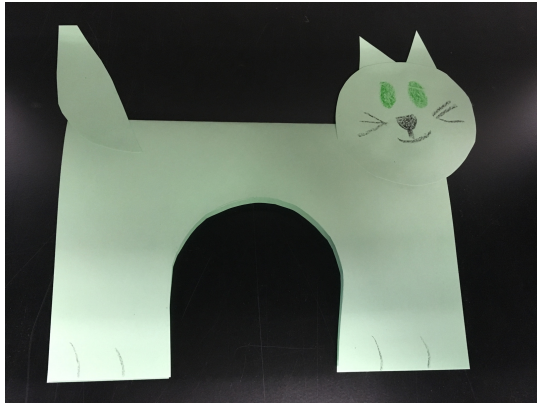

## INSTRUCTIONS



Materials Needed:

- Crayons
- Glue Sticks or Glue
- Paper (provided by the librarian)
- Scissors

This craft uses the scraps from the cut outs, so don't throw those away! If you need to, you can use extra paper to cut out the various parts.

- Step 1 - FOLD the paper along the straight line through the middle (hamburger style)
- Step 2 - Cut out both sides of the circle along the edge by following the dotted line
- Step 3 - Cut one of the remaining semicircles into a full CIRCLE by following the dotted line. This will become the cat's head
- Step 4 - Cut out the ears from the other remaining semicircle by following the TRIANGLE-shaped dotted lines
- Step 5 - Cut out the tail from that same semicircle scrap by following the remaining dotted line
- Step 6 - Glue the ears to the back side of the head
- Step 7 - Glue the head onto the front RIGHT side of the cat
- Step 8 - Glue the tail onto the front LEFT side of the cat
- Step 9 - You can EITHER color in the eyes, nose, mouth, whiskers, and toes OR you can cut those out from the remaining scraps and glue those onto the cat (and then color them in, if you wish)
- Step 10 - Color in the rest of the cat (if you want to)!
